

Admission Checklist for High School Seniors

✓ Apply for Admission

Send your application and required documents in after September 15 for the following fall or spring semester. To complete your application, you will need to submit:

- * Application (www.apply.wisconsin.edu)
- * \$44 application fee
- * High School Transcript
- * Official ACT or SAT test scores

✓ Apply for Financial Aid

After January 1 of each year, the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is available from your guidance counselor, the UW-WC Financial Aid office or online at www.FAFSA.ed.gov. The completed application should be submitted prior to April 15 to meet the priority filing date. Applications can be submitted after the priority date, but funds may be limited.

✓ Apply for Scholarships

Admitted freshmen are encouraged to apply for new freshman student scholarships. Over \$130,000 in student scholarships are awarded each year at UW-Washington County. UW-WC scholarship applications are available in mid-January (online or from the Student Services office). Completed applications are due in mid-March, with awards announced in May. ✓ After you Apply

When you receive your acceptance letter, information on the following will be sent to you:

- * English and Mathematics Placement Tests
- * When to submit fees (Fees include: \$25 Placement Test, \$50 Orientation, \$100 Advance Tuition Deposit - total of \$175)
- * New Student Orientation & Advising Session
- * Registering for Classes
